1. Purpose

This policy outlines the use, access, and payment procedures for Electric Vehicle (EV) chargers installed at school sites. It ensures fair access, transparent pricing, and efficient issue resolution.

2. Access to EV Chargers

School electric vehicle chargers are available at the following schools

- Bishop Ullathorne, Sports Hall 12KW x 2 sockets
- Christ The King, Westhill Road 7KW x 2 sockets
- St Augustine's, Carpark 7KW x 2 sockets
- St Elizabeth's, Carpark 7KW x 2 sockets
- St Thomas More, Carpark 7KW x 2 sockets
- St John Vianney, Carpark 7KW x 2 sockets

To initiate charging:

- Scan the Monta QR code located on the front of the charger.
- This will take you onto the Monta App for sign-in / registration
- Follow the on-screen instructions to begin charging via the Monta platform.

3. Charging Costs

Cost to Charging costs vary based on the time of day. Below is the current pricing structure:

Note: Prices are subject to change based on energy tariffs and operational costs. Updates will be communicated via school bulletins and signage at charging stations.

4. Payment Handling

- All payments are processed through Monta at the time of charging.
- Users will be prompted to pay via the Monta app or web interface after scanning the QR code.
- Monta collects the payment and transfers the appropriate amount to the school.
